• Every student is **required** to read *The Catcher in the Rye* by J.D. Salinger and *This Boy's Life* by Tobias Wolff. During the first weeks of school, students will be tested over *The Catcher in the Rye* and *This Boy's Life* and will receive an additional assignment to complete.
